



(J.W. Petry, legal son of F.M. Petri and Catharina Lippe from Olpe) -
Bürger und Pfannenschmied in Olpe (J.W. Petry's profession - Pfannenschmied, citizen in Olpe)
33 Jahre 1 Monat 13 Tage (his age)
die Eltern sind verstorben (parents have died already)
war noch nie verehelicht (has never been married before)
Maria Elisabeth Zeppenfeld, des Xaverius Zeppenfeld und der Maria Catharina Lackner eheliche Tochter
(start of right side page) Bürger und Tagelöhner in Olpe (Xaverius Zeppenfeld's profession) citizen and
worker, being paid day by day / 30 Jahre (30 years)
Der Vater hat die Einwilligung gegeben, die Mutter ist gestorben
Vater agreed to the marriage, mother is already dead
war noch nie verheiratet (has never been married before)
der einundzwanzigste November 21st (day of marriage)
the priests signature and names of the widesses Wilhelm Petry and Franz Adam ?
these names are crossed-out and replaced by Xaver Lorcan (?) and Franz Hüppen from Olpe.
